From Reverend Michael Peterson LENT MADNESS IS BACK

Once again this year, All Saints parishioners and friends have an opportunity to learn about some heroes of the Christian tradition and have some fun in the process by playing Lent Madness, starting next week on February 15.

Lent Madness follows the format of a pro sports bracket, and every day (except Sundays) during Lent, you get an opportunity to learn about two saints and then, along with other Anglicans, vote for the one that you like better (an entirely subjective process!). The saint with the most votes goes on to future rounds, until only one remains standing. Lent organized by Forward Madness is Movement, a publishing house of the US Episcopal Church. Last year, there were booklets containing descriptions of all the saints involved, that we distributed to the parish free of charge. Alas, those booklets are not available this year, but they are available as free download а here: SaintlyScorecard2024.pdf (lentmadness.org) If you don't have access to the internet but would like a print

copy, please let the office know and we can arrange that for you. Father Michael will also run a commentary on his blog, <u>www.madpadre.blogspot.com</u>,
