Our original sound system was installed well before COVID and was augmented to enable our live steaming. As we have grown our congregation, in person and online, we have felt the strain on our audio/visual system. We have sought to enhance our speaker system and have included additional screens, new microphones and a sound and lighting board to capture our vibrant worship services so that everyone at home and in church can see and hear them!

All of this comes with a considerable price tag.

We have received some designated funds to help with this expenditure and we are grateful to the international dinner team and the ACW for their support, and thank you to those who responded to our Giving Tuesday appeal, but even with a potential grant from the diocese, we need to raise \$15,000 to cover the shortfall.

From Reverend Michael Peterson LENT MADNESS IS BACK

Once again this year, All Saints parishioners and friends have an opportunity to learn about some



heroes of the Christian tradition and have some fun in the process by playing Lent Madness, starting next week on February 15.

Lent Madness follows the format of a pro sports bracket, and every day (except Sundays) during Lent, you get an opportunity to learn about two saints and then, along with other Anglicans, vote for the one that you like better (an entirely subjective process!). The saint with the most votes goes on to future rounds, until only one remains standing. Lent organized by Forward is Madness Movement, a publishing house of the US Episcopal Church. Last year, there were booklets containing descriptions of all the saints involved, that we distributed to the parish free of charge.
