All: Thanks be to God February 4th marked the 84th anniversary of the death of two Australian Airmen, L..A.C. Colin Tollhurst Arthur and L.A.C. Claude Murray Ross in whose memory and to the Glory of God, the stain glass windows showing St Michael and St George were installed in the west wall at the north end of the nave.
