

PSALM 118. *Confitemini Domino*



- 1 GIVE THANKS to the Lord, for he **is** good; * his mercy en-**dures** for ëv-ër.
- 2 Let Israel now **pro**-claim, * "His mercy en-**dures** for ëv-ër."
- 14 The Lord is my strength and **my** song, * and he has become **my** sal-vä-tion.
- 15 There is a sound of exultation and vic-**to**-ry * in the tents **of** the righ-tëous:
- 16 "The right hand of the Lord has **tri**-umphed! * the right hand of the Lord is exalted! the right hand of the **Lord** has trï-ümphe!"
- 17 I shall not die, **but** live, * and declare the **works** of thë Lörd.
- 18 The Lord has punished me **sore**-ly, * but he did not hand me **ov**-er tō dëath.
- 19 Open for me the gates of righ-**teous**-ness; * I will enter them; I will offer **thanks** to thë Lörd.
- 20 "This is the gate of **the** Lord; * he who is righ-**teous** may ën-tër."
- 21 I will give thanks to you, for you an-**swered** me * and have become **my** sal-vä-tion.
- 22 The same stone which the builders re-**ject**-ed * has become **the** chief cör-|ner-stöne. |
- 23 This is the Lord's **do**-ing, * and it is marvel-**lous** in öur eyes.
- 24 On this day the Lord has **act**-ed; * we will rejoice **and** be gläd | in it. |
- Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy **Spi**-rit: * as it was in the beginning, is now, and will be for **ev**-er. Ä-mën.
