## **From Reverend Michael Peterson**

**Our next Rector's Book Study will continue our focus on C.S. Lewis by looking at his book, *The Screwtape Letters*.** A junior devil, who is not very good at his job, receives advice from a senior devil, Screwtape, on how to tempt humans and lead them away from their faith. As he advises his young apprentice, "But do remember, the only thing that matters is the extent to which you separate the man from the Enemy (the devils' name for God). It does not matter how small the sins are provided that their cumulative effect is to edge the man away from the Light and out into the Nothing. Murder is no better than cards if cards can do the trick. Indeed the safest road to Hell is the gradual one—the gentle slope, soft underfoot, without sudden turnings, without milestones, without signposts."

The *Screwtape Letters* is a modern Christian classic and is full of insights on what genuine and lifegiving faith looks like. You can purchase it from the bookseller of your choice, and we will meet to discuss it in late April, date to be announced.

**Every few years,** all volunteers at All Saints are required to attend Safe Church training on how we can interact respectfully and properly with others, particularly with vulnerable individuals.

If it's been some years since you've done this training, or if you are new in a volunteer role, you need to complete this training, which can be done in several

ways. You can take the training online (see Nancy in the church office) or you can attend a special in-person afternoon that Fr. Michael has organized here at All Saints on Tuesday, April 16th, from 2-4pm. If you have questions about whether you need to take this training, please speak to your group leader, to Fr. Michael, or to one of the wardens.

**Our Easter mailing** is going out this week and contains a complete schedule for all of our Holy Week worship.

**On Palm Sunday, March 24th, our 9:30 service** will include a short prayer of commissioning as we ask God's blessing on all those who have recently stepped into a new role, including wardens, choristers, our new synod reps and archivist, and all others who are new in a volunteer role.
