Land Acknowledgement

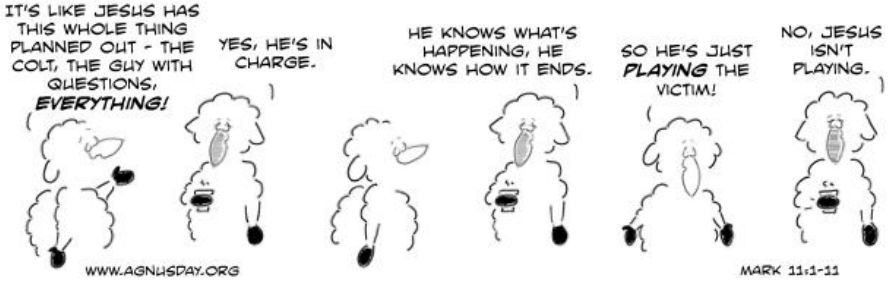
