## From the Green Team Reduce Your Environmental Footprint


What You Can Do - Buy <u>FSC</u> products to support responsibly sourced forest items About Sustainably managed forests protect wildlife habitat, Indigenous people's homelands and economic prosperity for forestry-dependent communities.

Ontario Nature is a long-time supporter of the Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) certification system as part of a solution to resolving competing demands on our forests. FSC is an international certification and labelling system promoting environmentally dedicated to beneficial socially appropriate, and economically prosperous management of the world's forests. FSC has developed a voluntary system of forest management certification and product labelling that enables people to identify responsibly sourced wood, paper and other forest products.

Screwtape, on how to tempt humans and lead them away from their faith. As he advises his young apprentice,"But do remember, the only thing that matters is the extent to which you separate the man from the Enemy (the devils' name for God). It does not matter how small the sins are provided that their cumulative effect is to edge the man away from the Light and out into the Nothing. Murder is no better than cards if cards can do the trick. Indeed the safest road to Hell is the gradual one-the gentle slope, soft sudden turnings, underfoot, without without milestones, without signposts."

The Screwtape Letters is a modern Christian classic and is full of insights on what genuine and lifegiving faith looks like. You can purchase it from the bookseller of your choice, and we will meet to discuss it in late April, date to be announced.

Every few years, all volunteers at All Saints are required to attend Safe Church training on how can we interact respectfully and properly with others, particularly with vulnerable individuals. If it's been some years since you've done this training, or if you are new in a volunteer role, you need to complete this training, which can be done in several ways. You can take the training online (see Nancy in the church office) or you can attend a special in-person afternoon that Fr. Michael has organized here at All Saints on Tuesday, April 16th, from 2-4pm. If you have questions about whether you need to take this training, please speak to your group leader, to Fr. Michael, or to one of the wardens.
