Our next Rector's Book Study will continue our focus on C.S. Lewis by looking at his book, *The Screwtape Letters*, A junior devil, who is not very good



at his job, receives advice from a senior devil, Screwtape, on how to tempt humans and lead them away from their faith. As he advises his young apprentice,"But do remember, the only thing that matters is the extent to which you separate the man from the Enemy (the devils' name for God). It does not matter how small the sins are provided that their cumulative effect is to edge the man away from the Light and out into the Nothing. Murder is no better than cards if cards can do the trick. Indeed the safest road to Hell is the gradual one the gentle slope, soft underfoot, without sudden turnings, without milestones, without signposts."

The Screwtape Letters is a modern Christian classic and is full of insights on what genuine and lifegiving faith looks like. You can purchase it from the bookseller of your choice. There will be an in-person session on Thursday, May 9, at 1:30pm.
