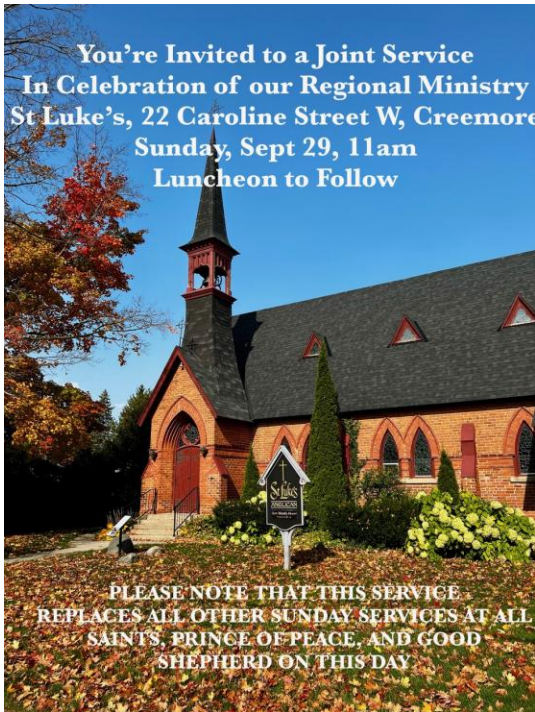

Our old defibrillator was past its prime, so we said goodbye and now have a loaner until our new one arrives. The cost of replacement is \$2,143.00, with a yearly cost of \$300 for monitoring, maintenance checks and for training of 12 people. Training date to be determined.
