

First Reading - Isaiah 52:7-10

#### Psalm 96



- 1 Sing to the Lord a new song;
  - \* sing to the Lord, all the whole earth.
- 2 Sing to the Lord and bless his name;
  - \* proclaim the good news of his salvation from day to day. *Refrain*
- 3 Declare his glory among the nations
  - \* and his wonders among all peoples.
- 4 For great is the Lord and greatly to be praised;
  - \* he is more to be feared than all gods. Refrain
- 5 As for all the gods of the nations, they are but idols;
  - \* but it is the Lord who made the heavens.
