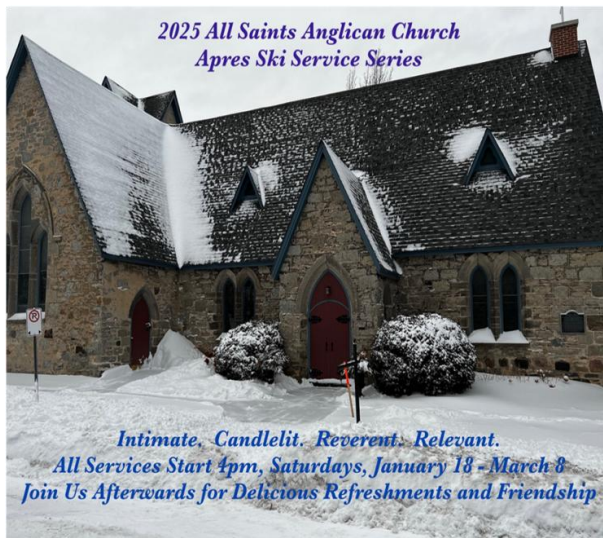

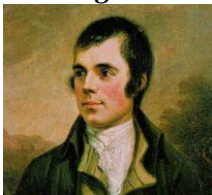


The Après Ski Series Returns to All Saints
