## **Vestry Meeting Social Justice Motion**

This year's vestry meeting will be asked to consider the Diocesan Social Justice Motion, "Protecting and Expanding Harm Reduction in Ontario". Every day in Ontario seven people die from drug overdoses. They are our children, brothers, and sisters, and neighbours. The motion calls on the Ontario government to reconsider its opposition to Supervised Consumption Sites. These sites provide safe places where people can consume illegal drugs while receiving counselling on addiction and personal health. The sites keep needles and syringes off our streets, they reduce calls on first responders and our health care system for overdose treatment, and they are often the only source of basic health care some people receive.
