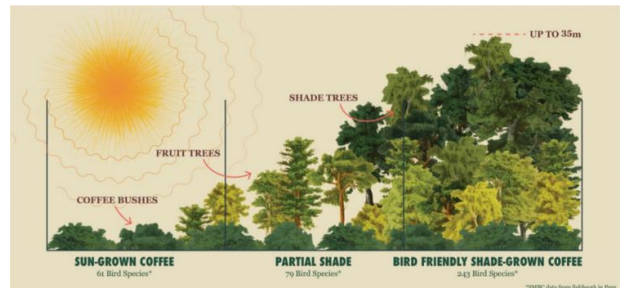

- Be a Responsible Consumer - Drink [bird friendly coffee](#) to support migratory birds

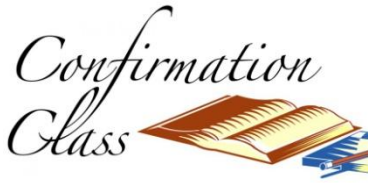
The quest for increased yield was not without consequences. It has led to massive loss of habitat for our migratory birds and their numbers have plummeted. Today, we see anywhere from 1/3 to 1/2 the populations of these amazing creatures relative to what we saw in the 1970's. Migratory birds face many challenges, but the loss of their winter habitat is one of the major threats to their survival.

Confirmation Classes to Be Offered

Confirmation in the Anglican Church used to be reserved for young adults, as an equivalent to the Roman Catholic practice of First Communion. Today confirmation is offered for baptized people of all ages who would like to do one or more of the following:

Deepen one's faith and knowledge of core Christian beliefs (the catechism). **Learn** more about the Anglican tradition (useful if you came from another church tradition and wonder why we do things the way we do).

Want to meet other companions on your spiritual journey?

The clergy team is planning a confirmation course for young adults and for adults of all ages, starting in May and running through May, June, and September. It will be open to members of all churches in our Regional Ministry. The course will begin with a shared meal, then move to zoom with occasional in person events and end with another shared meal. It will end in October with a confirmation service attended by our bishop.

Saturday, May 31st is the next **Season of Spiritual Renewal Diocesan** service at All Saints, Whitby, at 2pm. The first two services in this series featured lively music, inspiring preaching, and a warm atmosphere with Anglicans from all over our Diocese. Why not plan to join us?
