Prince of Peace Book Sale

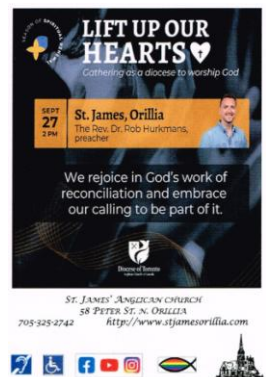
