Each year, the Diocese asks parishes to include a social justice motion as part of their vestry meetings. This year's motion concerns care of the planet and reads as follows:

"We, the parish of All Saints, Collingwood, in the Diocese of Toronto,

- Pledge to honour our baptismal commitment to "safeguard the integrity of God's creation" and
- urge the Government of Canada to honour its commitments to the Paris Accord, 2015: to reduce greenhouse gas (GHG)"

As many of you will remember, All Saints has a proud history of being a green parish. This year's vestry meeting is a good time for us to look at ways that we might make our parish more sustainable and more environmentally friendly.
