First Reading - Isaiah 52:13-53:12

Psalm 22



My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?

**\* and are so far from my cry and from the words of my distress?**

O my God, I cry in the daytime, but you do not answer;

**\* by night as well, but I find no rest.**

Yet you are the Holy One,

**\* enthroned upon the praises of Israel.**

Our forefathers put their trust in you;

**\* they trusted, and you delivered them. Refrain**

They cried out to you and were delivered; \*

**\* they trusted in you and were not put to shame.**

But as for me, I am a worm and no man,

**\* scorned by all and despised by the people.**

All who see me laugh me to scorn;

**\* they curl their lips and wag their heads, saying,**

"He trusted in the Lord; let him deliver him;

**\* let him rescue him, if he delights in him." Refrain**

Yet you are he who took me out of the womb,

**\* and kept me safe upon my mother's breast.**

I have been entrusted to you ever since I was born;

**\* you were my God when I was still in my mother's womb.**

Be not far from me, for trouble is near,

**\* and there is none to help.**

**\* they cast lots for my clothing. Refrain**

Be not far away, O Lord;

**\* you are my strength; hasten to help me.**

Save me from the sword,

**\* my life from the power of the dog.**

Save me from the lion's mouth,

**\* my wretched body from the horns of wild bulls.**

I will declare your name to my brethren;

**\* in the midst of the congregation I will praise you. Refrain**

Praise the Lord, you that fear him; stand in awe of him,

**\* O offspring of Israel; all you of Jacob's line, give glory.**

For he does not despise nor abhor the poor in their poverty;

**\* neither does he hide his face from them; but when they cry to him he hears them.**

My praise is of him in the great assembly;

**\* I will perform my vows in the presence of those who worship him.**

The poor shall eat and be satisfied, and those who seek the Lord shall praise him:

**\* "May your heart live for ever!" Refrain**

All the ends of the earth shall remember and turn to the Lord,
