## From Reverend Michael

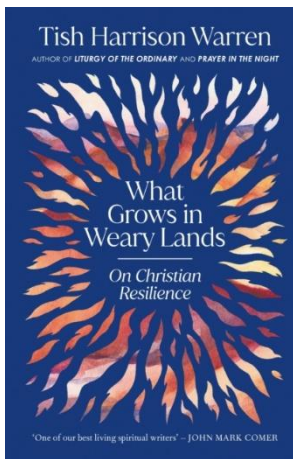

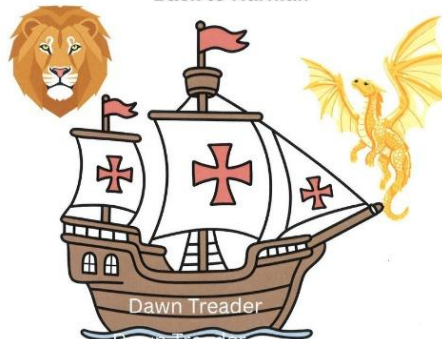
If you're looking for summer reading, Fr Michael recommends *What Grows In Weary Lands: On Christian Resilience*.
