The total profit was \$2,334

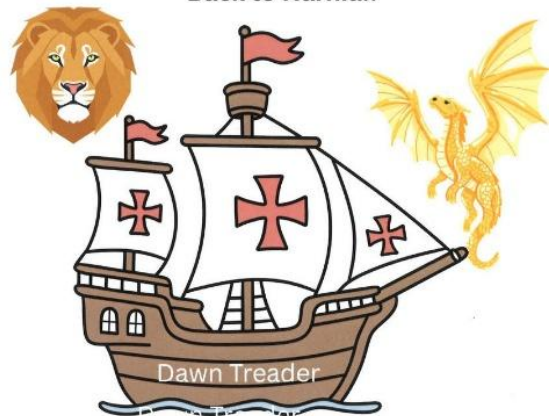
