The SMP (Sexual Misconduct Policy) Training and police record checks must be redone every three years.

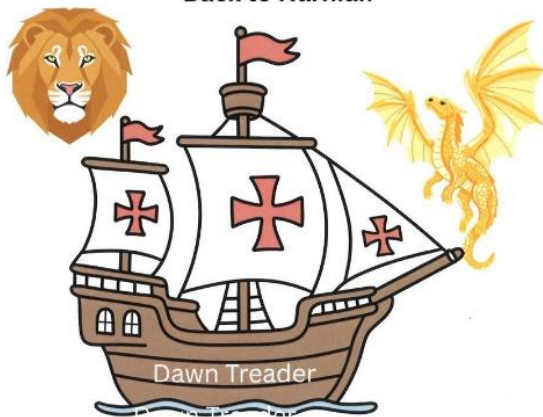
