Bonus: Reducing indoor heat means your AC works less, saving energy and extending its lifespan.

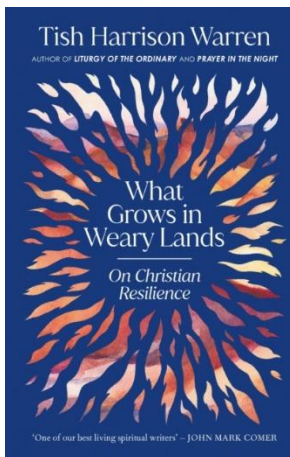
