Your air conditioner can't do its job if it's clogged with dust and debris.

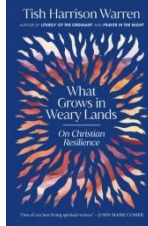
- Check and clean your AC filter every 30 days during high-use months.
