Open Windows at Night, Not Midday

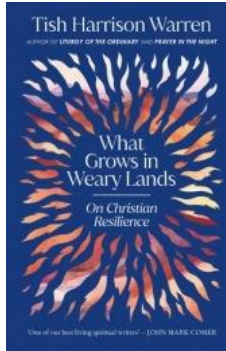
Let Mother Nature do the cooling.
