Lowering the temperature just a little can make a big difference.

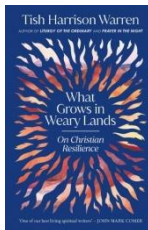
- Set your water heater to 49°C (120°F)-hot enough for hygiene, cool enough for savings.
