Time-of-use electricity rates can either cost or save you big.

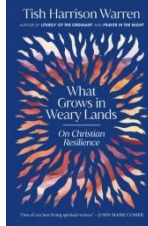
- In Ontario, run major appliances during off-peak hours: early morning or late evening.
